IT IS ORDERED appointing the Clerk of the Court, Michael K. Jeanes, or his designees as Special Commissioners pursuant to A.R.S. §12-211 and 12-212:

These appointed Special Commissioners shall have the authority to investigate and examine support and parent/child access (visitation) issues which are brought before them under the Maricopa County Plan for Expedited Process approved by the Supreme Court. Assigned Caseworkers may assist with the investigation and examination of support and access issues with results of their findings reported to the appointed Special Commissioners.

Resources subject to investigation and examination by the Special Commissioners and/or their Caseworkers in carrying out this authority may include, but are not limited to:

1. Documentation, evidence, and testimony presented by interested parties.
2. Clerk of the Superior Court records.
3. Credit Bureau Reports (i.e., TRW Profile Reports).
4. Employment and other income information.
5. Records of assets.
6. Records pertaining to the location of interested parties.

These Special Commissioners and their Caseworkers shall receive no additional compensation or benefits other than the compensation and benefits received as a result of their status as employees of the Clerk of the Superior Court.

This order supersedes all previous orders in this matter.
