ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 25-381.01 et. seq., Administrative Order 97-064, and the powers vested in the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County to appoint the Director of Conciliation Services, and upon the recommendation of the Family Court Presiding Judge and the Superior Court Administrator,

IT IS ORDERED that Melita Mulligan-Ferry is appointed as the Director of Conciliation Services effective Monday, March 19, 2001, to serve in that capacity with all the duties, powers, and responsibilities of the office.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Superior Court Administrator shall facilitate all administrative changes necessary to implement this order, including any necessary and reasonable compensation adjustments, as well as the allocation of sufficient staff and resources to allow for concomitant oversight of the Court's alternative dispute resolution (ADR) programs by Ms. Mulligan-Ferry, as Director of Conciliation Services.
