Pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Arizona, Art. 6, Sec. 24, A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91 of the Rules of the Supreme Court,

IT IS ORDERED that Richard L. Nothwehr is hereby appointed as a Court Commissioner of the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, effective January 21, 2002, on a full time basis, with the working title of "Hearing Officer".

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Richard L. Nothwehr shall have all such powers and duties pursuant to law which shall include, but not be limited to, those powers and duties prescribed by A.R.S. §12-213, as amended, and Rule 91, Rules of the Supreme Court, as amended.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Richard L. Nothwehr is assigned to hear any matter within the purview of his powers pursuant to law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Richard L. Nothwehr shall receive compensation at an annual salary of \$90,562.50 total, pro rated for the balance of the 2002-year. This appointment is conditioned upon his agreement to serve only for the compensation received as a Court Commissioner/Hearing Officer, and to receive no additional compensation or benefit, fiscal or otherwise, when he acts in the capacity of a Judge Pro Tempore, unless funds are made available by the Administrative Office of the Courts.
