ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
No. 2002-013

WHEREAS, Rule 6.3(d) of the Local Rules of Practice for the Court require a pleading party to include with all original filings a Family Court Cover Sheet in the form and containing the information designated by the Presiding Judge of the Family Court.

WHEREAS, the Family Court Cover Sheet is being used by the Case Coordinators of the Integrated Family Court Pilot Project to screen appropriate cases for inclusion in said project.

WHEREAS, the Court has instructed the Case Coordinators to include post-decree actions in the screening process for inclusion in said project.

IT IS ORDERED that a Family Court Cover Sheet be created in the form and containing the information designated by the Presiding Judge of the Family Court to include post-decree actions and be made available for filing by parties in those actions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that along with all original post-decree filings, the pleading party shall include said Family Court Cover Sheet in the form and containing the information designated by the Presiding Judge of the Family Court.

This Order is effective April 1, 2002.
