WHEREAS, the security and safety of the Trial Courts in Maricopa County, and the personnel who work and conduct business therein, is of paramount concern, and

WHEREAS, other urban trial courts are no longer authorizing attorney or employee bypass of security monitoring systems, and

WHEREAS, the Court is re-evaluating its Security Screening Bypass Policy,

IT IS ORDERED pending re-evaluation of the Security Screening Bypass Policy, no further employee, attorney or outside individual Applications for Security Screening Bypass Authorization will be issued until further Order of the Court. An implementation schedule will be set by the Trial Courts Administrator.

This Order supercedes any prior order or policy relating to security screening bypass, including the pending Court Security Bypass Policy of March 1997 and Administrative Order number 1996-047.
