WHEREAS, the timely processing of Support Orders is in the best interests of families and supports the Court's mission of providing timely, fair and impartial administration of justice and

WHEREAS, support orders generated through court processes require the administrative function of notifying payors and their employers of the court-ordered obligation to pay and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Superior Court in Maricopa County has established systems to automate the creation and distribution of support order wage assignments and

It appearing there is good cause for the appointment of Special Commissioners pursuant to A.R.S. §§ 12-211 and 12-212. Therefore,

**IT IS ORDERED**

1. This Order rescinds Administrative Order 2003-134.
2. Appointing the Clerk of the Superior Court, Michael K. Jeanes, or his designees as Special Commissioners for the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, for the purpose of signing Orders of Assignment pursuant to a signed Order for Child Support and/or Spousal Maintenance.
3. Appointing the Clerk of the Superior Court, Michael K. Jeanes, or his designees as Special Commissioners for the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, for the purpose of signing Orders to Modify Orders of Assignment pursuant to a signed Order Modifying Child Support and/or Spousal Maintenance.
4. Appointing the Clerk of the Superior Court, Michael K. Jeanes, or his designees as Special Commissioners for the Superior Court of Arizona in Maricopa County, for the purpose of signing Orders to Stop Orders of

Assignment pursuant to a signed Order to Stop Child Support and/or Spousal Maintenance.

5. Electronic signatures applied to the above Orders and Orders of Assignment shall carry the same force and effect as traditional ink signatures.

6. These appointments are effective upon date of signature and these Special Commissioners shall receive no additional compensation or benefits for performing this duty other than the compensation and benefits received as a result of their status as an employee of the Clerk of the Superior Court.
