Pursuant to A.R.S. 41-1750 (G) (9), A.R.S. Supreme Court Rule 123 and Administrative Order No. 2002-120, it is hereby ORDERED that the persons identified below shall have access to the court records specified in this ORDER, subject to the conditions set forth below:

1. This ORDER authorizes access by the following individuals to confidential and/or sealed court records for the purpose of conducting research by the Arizona State University Prevention Research Center for a study to devise and test a screening tool to identify case elements in Family Court cases with minor children that indicate the litigants who are at high risk to continue litigating:

2. The researchers identified in paragraph 1 shall be permitted to view the sealed and/or confidential records as part of the research study. Excluded are Child Protective Services reports or any other documentation the court may so specify. The researchers are permitted to collect data pertinent to the scope of the research project and shall ensure the confidentiality of records in accordance with A.R.S. 41-1750 (G) (9), A.R.S. Supreme Court Rule 123 and Administrative Order No. 2002-120
3. All persons identified in paragraph 1 shall have access to the case records in all cases selected for inclusion in the research study. The study will be conducted during the months of February through July of 2008, or such minimal additional time frame as may be necessary in order to complete the study. The researchers shall not disseminate any identifying information contained in such records to any person not participating in the research study.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED authorizing the Clerk of Court to provide access to the researchers named herein and associated with the Arizona State University Prevention Research Project to those records specified above in this order. Release of any sealed or confidential records contained in any case file referred to herein will be for the sole purpose of conducting research related to this project, and for no other purpose.
