ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 2008-107

On October 17, 2003, the Honorable Colin Campbell, Presiding Judge of the Superior Court in Maricopa County issued Administrative Order 2003-102 ordering Annette Clark to return all process and court logs to the Constable Administrator, as her services as constable for East Phoenix Justice Court, Number Two would not be required.

On July 10, 2008 the Court of Appeals issued a ruling regarding the supervisory authority a superior court presiding judge has over justice court constables, in response to the Administrative Order issued by Judge Campbell. The Court held that a presiding judge has supervisory authority to impose disciplinary sanctions against a constable, but, in exercising that authority, the presiding judge must give the constable notice, an opportunity to be heard, and an explanation of why such discipline is necessary.

In compliance with the ruling of the Court of Appeals, this Court shall give notice of a hearing to Annette Clark. However, in the interim, pending the outcome of the hearing on the notice of charges,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Administrative Order 2003-102 shall remain in full force and effect and process for East Phoenix Justice Court, Number Two, now known as Arcadia Biltmore Justice Court need not be served by Constable Annette Clark and her services are not required.
