IT IS FURTHER ORDERED appointing John Justin McGuire as Judge Pro Tempore for the purpose of performing wedding ceremonies, subject to the conditions and limitations of Canon 3, Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct, effective September 1, 2009, regarding the time and place of any such ceremonies and the receipt of any fee or compensation for performing weddings.
