Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR stated that the land investigated,

which is located in section 18 T24S R22E, had been irrigated within the past ten years, but no irrigation had occurred in the preceding five years. It also reported a domestic water use on the land. A well serves as the identified source of water that ADWR has determined is located within the subflow zone. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B. The land included in the boundaries of the WFR is labelled on the map as "(2)".

The WFR identified Statements of Claimant 39-3833, 39-3834, 39-3835, 39-12804, and 39-12805 as the relevant filings for the potential water right. Ted R. and Rose A. C. Smith filed the Statements of Claimant for water rights for irrigation, domestic, and stock watering. In 2008, Cheryl Yarbrough filed a form of assignment of the Statements of Claimant. On August 15, 2008, Cheryl Yarbrough and the Nature Conservancy signed and filed an assignment for Statement of Claimant 39-12805. In 2011, the Nature Conservancy assigned Statement of Claimant 39-12805 to the Arizona Game and Fish Commission.

The WFR lists Rose A. Clinton Smith as the owner of the property described in 111-23-DDD-002. According to the Cochise County Treasurer's Office, the Arizona Game and Fish Commission currently owns tax parcel 104-740-001D. A copy of the map from the Cochise County Treasurer's Office is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Rose A. C. Smith* and it will address the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-23-DDD-002 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimant, the current landowner, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file report who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.


