This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 111-24-DDB-001 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR found that 119.2 acres had been irrigated on land located in the south half of section 4 and the northeast quarter of section 9 T24S R24 but irrigation had been discontinued for the five years prior to the issuance of the WFR. A

copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. The land included with the boundaries of the WFR is shown on the map attached as Attachment B and labelled as "(1)".

The WFR identified Statement of Claimant 39-2297 (SOC) as the relevant filing for the potential water right. Phelps Dodge Corporation filed the SOC and subsequently amended it to claim rights to water for municipal, commercial, mining and stock watering uses.

Claimants & Landowners

On August 20, 2015, the SOC was the subject of an assignment from Phelps Dodge Corporation to Freeport Minerals Corporation, (the "Claimant"). The records of the Cochise County Assessor list Phelps Dodge Corporation as the owner of the property described in the WFR. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing tax parcels 102-36-015B and 102-36-015E is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Phelps Dodge Corporation II* and it will address the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-24-DDB-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, all persons who
 filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are included in the list on Attachment D,
 and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the court-approved mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Clerk will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list. Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.
- 4. Report. The Claimant shall file a Status Report on or by July 23, 2021. The Report shall state whether Claimant intends to withdraw the Statement of Claimant or pursue rights to appropriable water on the land. If Claimant does not intend to withdraw the Statement of Claimant, but will seek appropriable water rights, the Report shall state whether Claimant intends to file an amended Statement of Claimant. If Claimant intends to file an amended Statement of Claimant, the Report shall include the information that the Claimant must obtain to

file the Amended Statement of Claimant and the amount of time that Claimant reasonably believes necessary to file an amended Statement of Claimant.


