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and a diversion from the San Pedro River into the Pomerene Water Users Association Canal. A copy of the WFRs is attached as Attachment A. Rex Barney filed the applicable adjudication filing which is Statement of Claimant 39-4305. The records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not show that this Statement of Claimant has been assigned to a successor landowner. A copy of the map prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources for the WFR is attached as Attachment B. The purpose of this case is to resolve the six objections to those water rights to the extent that the current landowners intend to pursue them.

File Report No. 112-17-BAD-016 (WFR). The WFR listed the sources of water as three wells

Background

Until October 5, 2018, this case was consolidated and a part of that group of cases known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association*, contested case no. W1-11-1676. In that case, the court scheduled a status conference for June 28, 2017 in part to identify the proper parties in the case. A copy of the court's order was mailed, among others, to the D. Stadtler 2015 Trust, Robert Overson and Janet Overson. At the status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association was given until October 2, 2017 to provide documentation concerning its continuing authority to act. No landowners appeared at the status conference.

By order dated July 26, 2017, the court directed the landowners to file new or amended statements of claimant if they desired to assert a claim for a right to divert water through the Pomerene Canal for irrigation use. A second status conference was set for October 18, 2017. Copies of the order were sent to D Stadtler 2015 Trust, Dan J. and Nancy Stadtler, Robert Overson and Janet Overson and Riley Lake Holding LLC. No Statements of Claimant have been filed by D Stadtler 2015 Trust, Dan J. and Nancy Stadtler, Robert Overson and Janet Overson or Riley Lake Holding LLC.

At the status conference held on October 18, 2017, the newly elected board of the Pomerene Water Users Association appeared along with counsel. The court directed the Pomerene Water Users Association to file a list by December 29, 2017 that identified those landowners who are members by the Pomerene Water Users Association and whose interests will be represented by the Pomerene Water Users Association in the adjudication of water rights. The court also set a third status conference for September 6, 2018. Copies of the order were sent to D Stadtler 2015 Trust, Robert Overson and Janet Overson, and Riley Lake Holding LLC. On December 21, 2017, the Pomerene Water Users Association timely filed a list of 26 landowners that included Robert and Janet Overson and Riley Lake Holding LLC.

On August 31, 2018, Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of Termination. At the third status conference, counsel for the Pomerene Water Users Association provided a list of its members who joined the St. David Irrigation District and those members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District. Rilely Lake Holding LLC was listed as a member who elected to join the St. David Irrigation District. Robert and Janet Overson were listed as members who declined to join the St. David Irrigation District. Neither Daniel Stadtler nor D. Stadtler 2015 Trust was included on either list. Mr. Stadtler has not been identified as a member of the Pomerene Water Users Association, filed a Statement of Claimant or appeared at any status conference in the case in either his individual or trustee capacity.

By order dated October 5, 2018, the cases previously consolidated into a single case known as *In re Pomerene Water Users Association* were separated into individual cases. As a result, the potential water rights analyzed in the WFR will be considered in this separate case except to the extent that they will be joined with case established to adjudicate the water rights associated with the St. David Irrigation District.

Landowners

The first step to adjudicate the water rights identified by the WFR is to identify the current landowners involved in this case. According to information provided by the Cochise County Assessor's Office, the land included in the WFR consists of five tax parcels owned as follows:

The second step is to determine whether the wells listed in the WFR are located in the subflow zone. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that by November 16, 2018, the Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a map that shows Wells 1, 2, and 3 identified in the WFR relative to the boundaries of the Subflow Zone.

The third step is to determine whether the Landowners intend to pursue claims for potential water rights described in the WFR, and, if so, to schedule appropriate procedures to adjudicate those claims.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a telephonic status conference shall be held on November 29, 2018 at 1:00 p.m. to ascertain whether the Landowners in this case intend to pursue any of the potential water rights set forth in the WFR.

Based on the Warranty Deed filed on October 10, 2018 (document no. 2018-18642), in the Cochise County Recorder's Office, Lavon Womack, Rebecca Womack and Rodney and Sharon Xanos as Trustees of the Xanthos Revocable Trust, dated January 18, 2003 are successors in interest to Riley Lake Holding, LLC.

Water Case No. W1-11-1910, 601 West Jackson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003 by November 26, 2018 and shall provide a copy of the statement to each person listed on Attachment C. Failure to participate at the status conference or file a statement of intent may result in the dismissal of any claims associated with the land owned by the Landowner that is described in the WFR.




