This case originally involved potential water rights for irrigations uses, a primary storage reservoir and small reservoirs for use in sections 23 and 24 of T17S R20E that are the subject of watershed file report 112-17-BDA-007. It was initiated and consolidated with contested case In re Pomerene Water Users, contested case no. W1-11-1676, to adjudicate

water rights. On August 31, 2018, the Pomerene Water Users Association filed a Notice of Termination stating that St. David Irrigation District has claimed the Pomerene diversion structure and the Pomerene canal. On September 20, 2019, the trustees of the Kirkpatrick Trust filed a "Status Report and Request to Have Kirkpatrick Land Consolidated with St. David Contested Case No. W1-11-1675" stating that the land they own in Section 23 T17S R20E, Cochise County Assessor Tax Parcel No. 124-18-008B, is included within the boundaries of the St. David Irrigation District. They represented that they had filed a petition to be annexed into the St. David Irrigation District which is expected to be granted this month. The trustees move that the portion of this contested case dealing with the land they own be consolidated with *In re St. David Irrigation District*, contested case no. W1-11-1675.
