ORDER TO INITIATE CONTESTED CASE AND ORDER TO SET A TELEPHONIC STATUS CONFERENCE

This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed. Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation.

The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who filed Statements of Claimant with the Arizona Department of Water Resources to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

This contested case shall determine the claims for water rights listed in and resolve the objections to Watershed File Report 113-09-CC-038 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic, irrigation, and storage uses for the land described in the WFR located in sections 10 and 15 Township 11S Range 18E. The identified sources of water for the claimed uses are three wells located in sections 10 and 15 T11S R18E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that the wells used for irrigation water are located within the subflow zone. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B on which the land investigated is labelled with "(38)".

### Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified three Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water rights: 39-12296, 39-12297, and 39-12298. Clarence and Carol Moyers, Jerry Hammond, and Robert Floyd filed 39-12296 to claim water rights for irrigation, domestic, wildlife, and other uses. Jerry Hammond filed the remaining two SOCs. The Arizona Department of Water Resources listed Robert Floyd and Jerry Hammond as the owners of the property described in the WFR. According to the public records of Pima County Assessor's Office, Ronnie L. Hilliard, as trustee, owns tax parcel 205-19-003K. A copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

The public records maintained by ADWR do not include assignments of the SOCs. The Arizona Department of Water Resources lists SOC 39-171476 as filed by Ron Hilliard, Trustee

for a domestic water use on Section 29 Township 13S Range 13E, but no SOC for the land included in the boundaries of the WFR.

### IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Robert Floyd and Jerry Hammond* and it will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding Watershed File Report 113-09-CC-038 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, current landowner, all persons who filed objections to Watershed File Report 113-09-CC-038 who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

## 3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

5. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case, determine whether the Claimants or the current landowner intend to pursue water rights for the property. If so, then a discussion will be held to determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. The Telephonic Status Conference shall be held on September 25, 2020 at 2:30 p.m.




