Account

1. Procedural History

This case originally involved seven Watershed File Reports: 113-09-016, 113-12-005, 113-12-008, 113-12-009, 113-12-010, 113-12-011, and 113-12-024. By order dated May 25, 2017, contested case numbers W1-11-2666 and W1-11-2679 were separated from this case so that Watershed File Reports 113-12-011 and 113-12-024 were no longer at issue in this contested case. On February 8, 2018, contested case W1-11-2740 was consolidated with this case to resolve the objections to Watershed File Reports 113-13-007 with respect to water rights on land owned by the United States and leased by The Nature Conservancy. By minute entry dated June 19, 2018, dates were set by which the parties were to file motions for summary judgment and disclosure statements and complete discovery. A trial date was set for February 10, 2020. Subsequently, the United States filed a motion for summary judgment that was granted on October 31, 2018.

Proposed abstracts have been approved for the water rights for *de minimis* uses identified in Watershed File Reports 113-09-016, 113-12-005, and 113-12-008. In addition, proposed abstracts have been approved for instream flow and for *de minimis* stock watering uses identified in Watershed File Report 113-13-007.

No draft abstracts have been prepared for potential water rights in Watershed File Reports 113-12-009 or 113-12-010. These two watershed file report involve lessees and claimants other than the United States and The Nature Conservancy. According to the Report filed by the United States, the lessees of the land covered by these Watershed File Reports are C Spear Ranch and Mrs. Hope Jones (Estate). Statements of Claimant have been filed by or assigned to The Nature Conservancy, the Bureau of Land Management, Arizona State Land Department, C-Spear LLC, and C Spear Ranch – Estate of Hope I. Jones.

2. Proposed Abstracts for Water Rights for Stockpond Uses

Two proposed abstracts for water rights for stockpond uses identified by Watershed File Report 113-13-007 have been prepared and are attached as Appendix A for review by ADWR and then subsequently for suggested corrections from the parties.

3. Vacating Discovery Deadline and Trial Dates

Given the resolution of the claims for in-stream flow, no reason appears to exist that the issuance of proposed abstracts for the remaining claims will require either discovery or a trial.

4. Watershed File Report 113-12-009

The United States reported that the land described in Watershed File Report 113-12-009 is leased by C-Spear LLC. A copy of Watershed File Report 113-12-009 is attached as Appendix B. The Statements of Claimant included in that Watershed File Report were originally filed by the Bureau of Land Management and the State Parks Department (39-4870 and 39-4872¹) or have subsequently been assigned to The Nature Conservancy (39-5548, 39-5551, 39-5552, 39-5584, 39-5584, and 39-5597). It does not appear that the lessee has filed any claim for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Report 113-12-009. As claims for water rights have been resolved in this case with respect to claimants having outstanding statements of claimants involved with this Watershed File Report, no reason appears to not resolve the objections to and address the *de minimis* claims for water rights in Watershed File Report 113-12-009.

5. Watershed File Report 113-12-010

The water rights investigated in Watershed File Report are, according to the United States, on land leased by the Estate of Hope Jones. Statements of Claimant with respect to

those potential water rights have been filed by or assigned to C-Spear LLC, Arizona State Land Department and the Bureau of Land Management. Pursuant to A.R.S. §45-257 those claims for water rights will not be considered at this time and no proposed abstracts shall be prepared.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall review the legal descriptions of the points of diversion and places of use in the attached abstracts and verify the accuracy of the claimed water sources and facilities for points of diversions and places of uses. A report shall be filed by ADWR by May 13, 2019.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by April 19, 2019 the United States shall provide a list of any remaining claims for water rights analyzed by Watershed File Reports 113-09-016, 113-12-005, 113-12-008, and 113-13-007 that it seeks but are not currently included in an approved proposed abstract.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED vacating the discovery deadline and trial date set in this case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties, including the current lessee of the land included in Watershed File Report 113-12-009, shall have until **April 12, 2019** to file any objection it may have to the resolution of the potential water rights included in Watershed File Report 113-12-009.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States and The Nature Conservancy shall file a joint report by April 19, 2019 concerning the ownership of the water rights associated with Statements of Claimant 39-5548, 39-5551, 39-5552, 39-5584, 39-5584, and 39-5597 and, if those water rights are to be owned by the Bureau of Land Management, file an assignment of those statements of claimant by April 19, 2019.
