On August 6, 2019, the United States filed a Supplemental Response describing its investigation of six claims for water rights for which Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) did not find corresponding potential water rights in Watershed File Report Nos. 113-09-016 and 113-12-005. Based on its investigation, the United States determined to pursue water rights claimed in Statements of Claimant 39-5583, 39-5585, 39-8086, and 39-8434 and to withdraw Statements of Claimant 39-11589 and 39-11589.

In United States has requested four weeks to prepare proposed abstracts and assemble proof of beneficial use and present the same to ADWR. During the same time period, the United States proposes to schedule a meeting with Arizona State Land Department (ASLD) to address the location of a point of diversion on state trust land.

Given that objections have been filed in this case and ADWR did not classify the rights claimed by the United States as potential water rights,

IT IS ORDERED that the United States' shall submit to ADWR and all Objectors copies of proposed abstracts and proof of beneficial use related to Statements of Claimant 39-5583, 39-5585, and 39-8086, by September 3, 2019. Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a report by October 4, 2019 setting forth its comments on the proposed abstracts and information provided.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States shall meet with counsel for the Arizona State Land Department and file a report by September 3, 2019 regarding the status of the point of diversion associated with SOC 39-8434.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Statements of Claimant 39-11586 and 39-11589 are dismissed.
