Other cases in which claims have been made to water in the San 26 Pedro River watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or 27

awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant to use water from the San Pedro watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

This contested case shall determine the claims for water rights listed in and resolve the objections to Watershed File Report 113-12-DBC-009 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for domestic and irrigation uses for the land described in the WFR located in sections 04 and 10 Township 13S Range 19E. The identified source of water for the claimed uses is one well located in section 4 T13S R19E. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B and a copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified three Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water rights: 39-13669, 39-13670, and 39-13671. Ruth Teague filed the SOCs claiming domestic, irrigation and stockwatering use. The Arizona Department of Water Resources listed Norman G. and Barbara Y. Crawford as the owners of the property described in the WFR. The public records of Cochise County Assessor's Office show Stephen L. Brown as the owner of tax parcel 209-29-006D. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include an assignment of any of the SOCs from Ruth Teague to either the landowners identified by ADWR or the landowner shown by the public records of Cochise County. The public records maintained by ADWR included SOC 39-16653 filed by Stephen L. Brown for a domestic water use provided by a well, registration no. 55-211188, in which he claims a partial interest.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Norman G. and Barbara Y. Crawford* and it will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding Watershed File Report 113-12-DBC-009 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

- ADWR Report The Arizona Department of Water Resources shall file a report 5. by September 3, 2020, accompanied by a map, that shall identify whether the actual, physical location of the well registered by Stephen Brown is located within the boundaries of the WFR and within the subflow zone.
- 6. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case, determine whether the Claimants intend to pursue water rights for the property. If so, then a discussion will be held to determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. The Telephonic Status Conference shall be held on September 10, 2020 at 1:30 p.m.




