that identifies potential water rights for domestic and irrigation use in the southeast quarter of

section 23 T5S R15E. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. As shown on the map prepared by Arizona Department of Water Resources, the land included in the WFR is part of an area designated as IR001 that consists of two tax parcels: 30126023A and 30126028A. A copy of the map prepared by ADWR is attached as Appendix B. According to a deed recorded on May 31, 2017, The Nature Conservancy transferred the real property included in the two tax parcels to Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District. Neither the WFR nor the Court's file for the case includes a statement of claimant for the potential water rights in the WFR. A statement of claimant must be filed to proceed with a determination of water rights under A.R.S. §45-257(A)(1).

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Statement of Claimant. The landowner shall file with the Court a copy of the statement of claimant currently on file with ADWR that landowner believes makes a claim for water rights for the land included in the WFR in the southeast quarter of section 23 T5S R15E by October 18, 2019. If landowner cannot locate a previously filed statement of claimant for water rights for the land included in the WFR, it shall file a statement of claimant with ADWR with a copy to the Court by October 18, 2019.
- 2. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall address the objections that were filed to the watershed file report 114-01-CCD-012 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991).
- 3. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports, the landowner, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.
- 4. <u>Consolidated Case.</u> This case shall be consolidated with contested case no. W1-11-3107.


