the San Pedro Watershed ("San Pedro HSR") filed on November 20, 1991. In 1994, the Special

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Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed.

Once the proposed water right abstracts have been prepared, "the litigants will be provided an opportunity to suggest the correction of mistakes in the proposed abstracts." Decision, p. 47. This proceeding is not a forum in which to relitigate the Decision, which was the subject of years of briefing and has now been affirmed for more than 14 years. Subsequently, these abstracts will be included in a catalog of proposed water rights where they will be subject to very limited set of objections and ultimately in a final decree.

Proposed water right abstracts have been prepared for the *de minimis* water rights included in the WFR by the Claimant, reviewed by Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR"), and resubmitted by the Claimant. Two issues still exist between the abstracts as drafted by Claimant and the Report filed by ADWR on January 17, 2020.

First, the WFR identified the purpose of the potential water rights attached as "small reservoirs" using the abbreviation "SR". In the San Pedro HSR, ADWR explained that "common reservoir purposes are: regulation of irrigation supply, fish-rearing, wildlife, recreation, stockwatering, or flood control." Vol. 1 San Pedro HSR at 165. The description used in the attached abstracts is both consistent with ADWR's explanation of the purposes of small reservoirs and beneficial purposes recognized under A.R.S. §45-181(1). Accordingly, the original designation of "SR" that ADWR attached to the potential water right is retained in the abstracts.




FIGURE 1. Map prepared by ADWR that includes the legal description of a parcel to the north of the subject well obtained from the Pinal County Assessor.

The second issue concerns the location of Well 55-515185 within the southwestern quarter of section 8 T6S R16E. See figure 1. Claimant and ADWR both agree that the well is located in the 10-acre northeastern quarter-quarter. They do not agree whether the well is located in the western or eastern half of the southwestern quarter of section 8 T6S R16E. Based on the depiction of the location of the well figure 1 and the legal description by the Pinal County Assessor of the tax parcel to the north as shown on figure 1, the legal description offered by Claimant (NENWSW Sec. 8) has been included in the abstracts for 114-04-BAB-007-SR001 and 114-04-BAB-007-SR002.


