300-26-019A owned by Pablo Calderon, Amanda Morales-Calderon, Felix Morales, Maria Carolina Burnam, and Robert Morales.

This contested case is one of the many cases that are included in the General Stream Adjudication. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the water rights of those persons who use water from the San Pedro watershed in addition to the watersheds for the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria and Upper Santa Cruz. Other cases in the General Stream Adjudication have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. This case is initiated to determine water rights to water in the San Pedro watershed.

Claims for Water Rights

This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to the Zone 2 Well Report 114-04-BAD-008 ("Report") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The Report identified domestic and irrigation uses on land located in sections 16 and 17 Township 6S Range 16E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources did note that no irrigation had occurred on the land in the five years prior to its investigation. The Report identified the source of water for the claimed use as a well located in section 16 T6S R16E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that the well is located in the subflow zone. A copy of the Report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the Report is attached as Attachment B on which the land in question is labelled as "(8)". A copy of the maps prepared by the Pinal County Assessor showing tax parcels 300-26-011D-G, and 300-26-019A, are attached as Attachment C.

Claimant & Landowner

The Report identified one Statement of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-11538. Jose R. and Rita Morales filed the SOC claiming water for domestic and

irrigation use. Jose and Rita Morales filed a Uniform Questionnaire on October 31, 1988, that described water used for domestic use and a two-acre garden. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of the SOC.

The Report lists Jose and Rita Morales as the owners of the property described in the Report. A death certificate has been recorded with the Pinal County Recorder's Office for Jose Romero Morales with respect to tax parcel 300-26-011D. *See* Fee Number 1998-007052. Also recorded with the Pinal County Recorder's Office are quit claim deeds from Rita Morales to Maria Carolina Burnam (Fee Number 2004-009647), Robert Morales (Fee Number 2006-132670), Felix Morales (Fee Number 2006-077802), and Pablo Calderon and Amanda Morales-Calderon (Fee Number 2015-035098). According to the records of the Pinal County Assessor, Felix Morales, Maria Carolina Burnam, Robert Morales, and Pablo and Amanda Calderon own tax parcels 300-26-011D-G, and 300-26-019A.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Jose and Rita*Morales and it will determine water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Report 114-04-BAD-008 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are included on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u>

The Special Master's office will email courtesy copies of orders and minute entries entered in this case to persons listed on Attachment D. Requests for inclusions on the email list should be sent to Barbara Brown at brownb099@superiorcourt.maricopa.gov.

5. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether Rita Morales intends to pursue the claim for a water right or whether the current landowners intend to assert a claim for a water right and, if so, whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Scheduling

Conference. 




Figure 1. Larger area including the land at issue as mapped by the Pinal County Assessor
