This case involves potential water rights for irrigation and domestic use. This Order initiates a contested case to resolve objections to watershed file reports 114-04-BDD-001 and 114-04-BDD-029 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey

WFR 114-04-BDD-001

The watershed file report lists one domestic water use and three irrigation water uses. The report lists Statements of Claimant 39-1976, 39-1977, 39-1978, and 39-2482, as the applicable adjudication filings. Three statements of claimant, 39-1976, 39-1977, and 39-1978 have been assigned to Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District, a municipal corporation ("SRP"). ASARCO, Incorporated filed Statement of Claimant 39-2482.

The locations of the uses of water are described as sections 9 and 10 in T7S R16E. A well located in SESENW 10 T7S R16E is identified as the source of water. A copy of the map prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources for WFR 114-04-BDD-001 is attached as Attachment B. The watershed file report named William M. and Gloria Stambaugh as the landowner. Based on the public records maintained by the Pinal County Assessor's Office, the relevant land described as the places of use include tax parcels 3003006B and 30034010A, both of which are owned by SRP. A copy of the map prepared by the Pinal County Assessor's Office of the relevant land is attached as Attachment C. At the initial scheduling conference, SRP shall be prepared to state whether the well which provides the source of water is located within the subflow zone.

WFR 114-04-BDD-029

The watershed file report lists one domestic water use and three irrigation water uses. It lists Statements of Claimant 39-4843, 39-4844, 39-4845, and 39-4846 as the applicable adjudication filings for the potential water rights. Statement of Claimant 39-4843 was filed by

Edwin Ash and the public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources do not show that it has been assigned. Statements of Claimant 39-4844, 39-4845, and 39-4846 have been assigned to the Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District.

The locations of the uses of water are described as within the northwest quarter of section 4 T7S R16E. A well located in NESWNW 4 T7S R16E is identified as the source of water. A copy of the map prepared by the Arizona Department of Water Resources for WFR 114-04-BDD-029 is attached as Attachment D. The watershed file report named Donovan Simonis as the landowner. Based on the public records maintained by the Pinal County Assessor's Office, the relevant land described as the places of use includes tax parcel 30031003A, which is owned by SRP. A copy of the map prepared by the Pinal County Assessor's Office of the relevant land is attached as Attachment E. At the initial scheduling conference, SRP shall be prepared to state whether the well which provides the source of water is located within the subflow zone.
