4 claimant and the required report by **February 15, 2018**.

5 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the deadline for filing responses to TNC's
6 claims due on **December 8, 2017** is vacated.

8 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that the status conference scheduled for **Friday,**
9 **December 15, 2017, at 10:30 a.m.** shall not be vacated and shall be held as scheduled for the
10 purpose of receiving a more extensive status report regarding TNC's claims, the status of the
11 production of reports from ADWR referenced in TNC's motion, and the status of objections
12 to TNC's claims.
