DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Contested case W1-11-3320 initiated and status conference set for July 18, 2019 at 1:30 PM

DATE OF FILING: June 7, 2019

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This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-04-ADC-001 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identifies potential water rights for domestic, irrigation and small reservoir uses for the land described sections 03 and 04 Township 7S Range 17E. A copy of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the

prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Landowners and Sources of Water

The WFR identified Donald E. and Beverly A. Geldmacher as the owners of the land marked as (1) on the map attached as Attachment B. Included in the public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) is a copy of Statement of Claimant 39-2116 dated December 5, 1979, claiming a right to water for irrigation, domestic, and stock and wildlife watering. On November 29, 1984, Donald and Beverly Geldmacher filed Statement of Claimant 39-11371 to amend Statement of Claimant 39-2116 following a flood in 1983. Statement of Claimant 39-11371 reduced the claimed amount of irrigation use from 3,650 acre feet annually (AFA) to 3,052 AFA and increased stock watering use to 600 AFA.

On April 5, 1988, Donald and Beverly Geldmacher deeded the land described as an irregular parcel of land in the northwest quarter of section 04 T7S R 17E which lies south and east of Aravaipa Road to The Nature Conservancy. The Warranty Deed further stated:

Grantors further grant one-half (1/2) of the flow of the appurtenant water rights from Aravaipa Creek, constituting 100 miner's inches, as is evidenced by the recording at Book 3 Miscellaneous, page 408 of the records of the Pinal County Recorder; reserving to themselves the remaining one-half (1/2) interest in said water rights, constituting an additional 100 miner's inches. Grantors further grant to Grantee an undivided one-half (1/2) interest to the use of, and an undivided one-half (1/2) interest in the responsibility for the maintenance and upkeep of, the intake works and conveyance system located in Lot 4 of Section 3, Township 7 South, Range 17 East, G.&S.R.B.&M. historically utilized for beneficially using said water right.

On June 1, 1988, Mr. Geldmacher filed an assignment of a portion of SOCs 39-2116 and 39-11371 to The Nature Conservancy. On August 7, 1991, The Nature Conservancy filed amendments to 39-2116 and 39-11371 to reflect a change of use of the water in Aravaipa Creek to instream use without diversion or impoundment. On March 6, 1995, ADWR

approved the assignment of Statement of Claim 36-32525 for 19 acres to The Nature Conservancy.

On December 14, 1994 Donald and Beverly Geldmacher signed a "Water Deed" that included language similar to that quoted above that named Linda Swisher, Trustee of The Willis R. Dortch Revocable Trust as the grantee. An accompanying form of assignment of SOC 39-2116 was filed on January 10, 1995 with ADWR that named Linda Swisher of the Willis R. Dortch Revocable Trust as the assignee. On August 28, 2002, Linda Swisher, as trustee, signed a Warranty Deed in favor of Carol Steele for land in Section 04 T7S R17E.

In 1994, Donald and Beverly Geldmacher filed an Application for Assignment for Statements of Claim 36-0100139, 36-0100141, 36-010042, 36-0100143, and 36-0100144 in favor of Linda Swisher, Trustee of The Willis R. Dortch Revocable Trust. In 1998, Donald and Beverly Geldmacher signed and filed with ADWR a form to convey Statement of Claim 36-32525 to The Nature Conservancy.

According to the Pinal County Assessor's Office, the land included in the WFR has been divided into seven new parcels as shown on Attachment C and listed as follows:

The Nature Conservancy owns 300-42-001G and that land has already been mapped and is the subject of proposed abstract 115-04-011-WL001, a copy of which is attached as Attachment E.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Geldmacher* and will address objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 115-04-ADC-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment D, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.

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C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u>

5. Status Conference. An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case, determine the basis of claims for water rights, and ascertain whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. The Nature Conservancy shall be prepared to identify at the status conference which, if any, claims it intends to assert in this contested case and identify the documents on which it bases its claims. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. 


AN EXTENSIVE COMMENT WAS RECEIVED PERTAINING TO THE CONCLUSIONS PRESENTED IN THE 1987 PRELIMINARY HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEY REPORT WHICH DETAILED DIVERSION AND USE LOCATIONS. THE LAND OWNER DIVERTS WATER FROM ARAVAIPA CREEK THROUGH HIS FIELDS IN AN EFFORT TO RECLAIM CROPLANDS, THROUGH SEDIMENTATION, WHICH WERE DAMAGED OR DESTROYED IN THE 1983 ARAVAIPA CREEK FLOOD. D.W.R. ESTIMATES THE AMOUNT DIVERTED ANNUALLY TO BE APPROXIMATELY 1,947 ACRE-FEET. TAILWATER IS IMMEDIATELY RETURNED TO ARAVAIPA CREEK AT THE LOWER END OF THIS PROPERTY.


