The following attorneys and parties appear in-person: Charles Cahoy on behalf of the City of Phoenix; Stanley Lutz on behalf of the AZ Chapter of the Nature Conservancy; Mark McGinnis on behalf of the Salt River Project; and Joe Sparks on behalf of the San Carlos Apache Tribe and Tonto Apache Tribe.

The following attorneys and parties appear telephonically: Julian Miranda and Sandra Pusey; Kimberly Parks on behalf of the Arizona Department of Water Resources; and Jay Tomkus on behalf of Pascua Yaqui Tribe and Yavapai-Apache Nation.

Court reporter, Celeste Paxton Jones, is present and a record of these proceedings is made digitally.

The Court calls the case and Julian Miranda, who previously had been present telephonically, has not called back.

Mr. Lutz makes an oral motion for the Nature Conservancy to intervene.

IT IS ORDERED granting the oral motion to intervene.

The Court stands at recess in this case.

The Court addresses Mr. Miranda regarding the piece of property that he owns for which a claim for water rights was made.

Julian Miranda indicates that he is not representing the other landowners: Miguel Miranda, Christopher Miranda, Francisca Islas, and Mariana Miranda.

Julian Miranda and Sandra Pusey state their interest in pursuing the claim for water rights. They agree to a meeting with neighboring landowners, the objectors, and Arizona Department of Water Resources.

There being no objection from the other parties,

IT IS ORDERED directing Ms. Parks to schedule a meeting with ADWR by July 26, 2019.
