ORDER TO INITIATE CONTESTED CASE

CONTESTED CASE NAME: In re Ruben and Delta Bryce

OF ALL RIGHTS TO USE WATER IN THE GILA RIVER SYSTEM AND

HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Contested case W1-11-3386 is initiated and status conference set for September 12, 2019 at 2:10 p.m.

This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-05-AC-007 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified a potential water right for irrigation for the land described in the WFR located in section 34 of Township 6S Range 19E. The WFR located one well that supplied the identified water uses: W01. Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) has determined that W01 is located in the subflow zone. A copy

of the watershed file report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified two Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water right: 39-2579 and 39-12545. On December 28, 1979, Delta Bryce filed SOC 39-2579 claiming 13.8 acre-feet annually for 2.3 acres of land located in the NWNE section 34 T6S R19E supplied by a well located in the NWNWNE section 34 T6S R19E. The WFR lists the location of well, W01, as within NENWNE of section 34 T6S R19E. The WFR also identified that W01 is shared with WFR 115-06-AC-006 which is part of contested case W1-11-3385. The public records of Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) do not include an assignment of SOC 39-2579.

Elizabeth Hilliard filed SOC 39-12545 claiming 0.6 acre-feet annually for domestic and stockwater uses supplied by a well located in NWNE section 34 T6S R19E. The public records of ADWR do not show an assignment of SOC 39-12545. The WFR for 115-05-AC-006 also included SOC 39-12545 which is part of contested case W1-11-3385.

The WFR identified Delta and Ruben Bryce as the landowners of the land included in the WFR. The public records of the Graham County Recorder's Office show Re[u]ben A. Bryce died in June of 1966 leaving Delta Bryce entitled to the land "by intestate succession as sole heir" according to Affidavit of Succession to Real Property filed by Delta Bryce on July 6, 1993. On July 6, 1993, Delta Welker Bryce conveyed to Delta Welker Bryce as trustee of the Delta Welker Bryce Living Trust the land described as:

The Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 34, Township 6 South of Range 19 East, G.S.R.B. & M., Graham County, Arizona; EXCEPTING there-from the following described tract of land, to-wit: The East ½ of the East ½ of the Northwest ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 34.

On September 26, 2002, Greta Bergan and Logene Allen, as successor Co-Trustees of the Delta Welker Bryce Living Trust, removed this land from trust. On September 4, 2008, Greta Bergan conveyed a one half interest in the land to herself as Trustee of the Greta Bergan Trust. On December 14, 2011, Logene Allen conveyed a one half interest in the land to herself as trustee of the Logene Allen Living Trust and her successors. According to the Graham County Assessor's Office, the land at issue is tax parcel no. 110-14-012. A copy of the current tax parcel map is attached as Attachment C.

Greta Bergan filed a land survey on December 1, 2016 showing the land held by the two trusts, adjacent to the land owned by John Franzone. A copy of the land survey is included as Attachment D.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Ruben and Delta Bryce* and it will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding the Watershed File Report 115-05-AC-007 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp
- 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment E, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment E to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

4. <u>Courtesy Email List.</u>

5. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case, ascertain whether the current landowners intend to pursue claims for water rights, and determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. No party shall conduct any discovery or file any motions prior to the Scheduling Conference. The Status Conference shall be held on **September 12**, **2019**, at 2:10 p.m. before:




Figure 1. Land at issue in this case is labelled as (7).






Figure 2. Land included in 115-05-AC-006 is labelled as (6) and the land shown in this case is labelled as (7).
