This Order initiates two contested cases to consider the claims for water rights asserted in Statements of Claimant 39-2140, 39-2148, 39-2149, and 39-2155 signed by R. Bruce Whiting as a partner of Whiting Ranches, an Arizona general partnership. Arizona

Department of Water Resources investigated the claims and reported the results of its investigation in Zone 2 Well Report 115-05-DA-003 (Report), Watershed File Report 115-05-036 (WFR), and a catalog entry on page 293 of Vol. 8 of the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991).

The Report located existing irrigation of land in sections 17, 20, and 21 of Township 7S Range 20E in Graham County and six small reservoirs. Three wells provide the sources of water for the irrigation and reservoir uses. Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR) has determined that the wells listed below that serve as the sources of water for the identified water uses are located in the subflow zone:

A copy of the Report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map of the Report area is duplicated on Attachment B.

The WFR identified two potential water uses (PWR). It found a domestic use dependent on a well located in section 8 T7S R12E, specifically described in the catalog entry, and it found a stock watering use supplied from the surface water of Aravaipa Creek. A copy of the WFR is also attached as Attachment A. A copy of the catalog entry is attached as Attachment C. A map showing the location of the water uses described in the WFR is included on Attachment B.

### Claimants

Three sets of Statements of Claimant must be addressed in this case. The first group consists of Statements of Claimant considered by ADWR and included in its investigative documents. The second set consists of a Statement of Claimant filed for land included in the mapped area of the Report but not referenced by ADWR. The third set of Statements of Claimant are documents filed by the landowner after 1991. Each type of Statement of Claimant will be addressed separately.

### 1. Statements of Claimant considered by ADWR

The Report identified three Statements of Claimant (SOC) relevant to the potential water rights: 39-2140, 39-2148, 39-2149. Whiting Ranches filed the SOCs on December 28, 1979. SOC 39-2140 corresponds to an irrigation claim for 300 acre-feet annually (AFA); SOC 39-2148 corresponds to a stock watering claim for 0.36 AFA; and, SOC 39-2149 corresponds to a stock watering claim for 4.6 AFA.

The public records of ADWR show that Kaibab Industries, Inc. filed a form of assignment of the three SOCs on November 14, 1994, each one signed only by the assignee, Kaibab Industries, Inc. On June 6, 1996, Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender filed an assignment of SOC 39-2140 from Kaibab Industries, Inc. to Susan S. and Michael J. Cavender signed by both the assignor and the assignee, found under the public records of ADWR for SOC 39-2148. Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender filed another assignment of SOC 39-2140 on February 21, 2013 signed only by the assignees and filed an amendment to SOC 39-2140. The public records of ADWR do not show any further assignments that reference SOCs 39-2148 and 39-2149.

The WFR lists a single statement of claimant. Whiting Ranches filed SOC 39-2155 on December 28, 1979 claiming 100,000 gallons annually for stockwatering on the land included in the WFR. The public records include a form of assignment of SOC 39-2155 to Kaibab Industries, Inc. signed only by the assignee. The public records do not show a further assignment of SOC 39-2155.

### 2. Statement of Claimant Not Considered by ADWR

A search of ADWR's public record discloses SOC 39-6479 filed by Robert F. Kramme on July 7, 1980 for a well for a stockwatering use located within the mapped boundary of the land included in the Report. Until the recording of a deed on July 5, 1983, Mr. Kramme held title to property in the southwest quarter of section 17 T7S R20E. The property was included in a deed recorded on April 18, 1988 with the Graham County Recorder naming Kaibab Industries as the grantee. On May 21, 1992 Kaibab Industries filed an assignment form for SOC 39-6479 signed only by assignee Kaibab Industries. The Report does not reference SOC 39-6479 and no indication of a well is shown on the map in the location identified in SOC 39-6479.

### 3. Statements of Claimant filed after 1991

Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender filed SOC 39-17713 for a domestic use for a well located in the NWSENW section 21 T7S R20E which generally corresponds to W01 in the Report. The Cavenders also filed SOC 39-17717 for another domestic use associated with a well located in NESENW section 21 T7S R20E which generally corresponds to W03 identified in the Report. To the extent that these SOCs and other SOCs filed after the

completion of Report do not correspond to wells in the Report, those SOCs will not be considered in this contested case.

#### Landowners

The Report and the WFR identified the landowner as Withrow Ranch, Inc. According to the public records of the Graham County Recorder's Office, Withrow Ranch, Incorporated, a California corporation, conveyed land in the E1/2 of Section 7, the SW1/4 of Section 8, the E1/2 and the W1/2 of the NW1/4 of section 17, the E1/2 of section 17, and the NW1/4 with the E1/2 of the E1/2 of section 21 T7S R20E to Whiting Ranches, an Arizona general partnership on March 24, 1994. On July 21, 1994, Whiting Ranches included this land in a Special Warranty Deed to A. Milton and Lorana Whiting, R. Bruce Whiting, and Gail Whiting who conveyed the land to Payson West, an Arizona general partnership. Approximately five days later, Payson West conveyed the land to Kaibab Industries, Inc., an Arizona corporation.

On January 19, 1996, Kaibab Industries conveyed part of the land described in the Report to Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender by a Joint Tenancy Deed. On April 20, 1998, Kaibab Industries, Inc. conveyed another portion of section 21 T7S R20E to Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender by Warranty Deed. According to the public records of the Graham County Assessor's Office, Michael J. and Susan S. Cavender are the current owners of tax parcel no. 110-45-034.

On December 13, 1999 and May 2, 2007 Kaibab Industries, Inc. deeded land in section 17 T7S R20E to Adell Calloway who is the current owner of tax parcel no. 110-45-025G. Also on May 2, 2007, Kaibab Industries, Inc. conveyed part of the east half and west half of section 17 T7S R20E to Primero Group, LLC, an Arizona limited liability company.

Primero Group, LLC conveyed land located in the NW1/4 of section 17 T7S R20E to Matthew O. and Anna M. Magoffin as Trustees of the Magoffin Family Trust. Matthew O. and Anna M. Magoffin are the current landowners of tax parcel no. 110-45-033. Matthew O. and Anna M. Magoffin also own tax parcel no. 110-45-021C which includes land in sections 17, 20, 21, 28, and 27 of T7S R20E. The landowner of the land to the northeast of West Klondyke Road was not able to be determined following a public records search of the Graham County Assessor's Office and Recorder's Office. A map of the current tax parcels is attached as Attachment D.

### **De Minimis Claims**

The potential water rights in this case include a claim for stock watering. In 1994, the Special Master issued a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed. This procedure applies to the water right for the stock watering use identified in the WFR. As required by the Decision, a proposed water right abstract has been prepared for the *de minimis* water right, which is attached as Attachment E. Draft abstracts have also been prepared with respect to the small reservoirs identified in the Report, which are attached as part of Attachment E.

IT IS ORDERED that ADWR shall review the proposed abstracts and file its report by August 30, 2019.

### IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case, Consolidation, Designation and Docket Number</u>. This contested case initiates case nos. W1-11-3359 and W1-11-3397. The two contested cases are

consolidated under *In re Whiting Ranches*, Contested Case No. W1-11-3397. It will address Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed regarding the Zone 2 Well Report 115-05-DA-003 and Watershed File Report 115-05-036 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the claimants, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment F, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

### 3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment F to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.

5. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to address the adjudication of this case and determine whether the objections to the potential water rights can be settled. If the objections cannot be settled, then a subsequent date will be set for a scheduling conference to identify issues, file disclosure statements, conduct discovery, submit prehearing motions, and hold a trial. 




