The Court thanks Mr. Brown for confirming the status of the matter. The Court will send out an order giving the property owners an additional thirty days to claim water rights. If no claimants come forward at that time, the Court will dismiss the matter.

Mr. McGinnis addresses the other matters that are tied into the same Statement of Claimants and notes that Statement of Claimant 39-86831 has already been dismissed in the Stradling case.

The Court notes that she will take a further look at the Stradling case.
