The Hopi Tribe, the United States and Salt River Project jointly moved to vacate the oral arguments set for motions filed by the Hopi Tribe and Salt River Project scheduled for May 8, 2020 as follows:

Hopi Tribe's Motion in Limine No. 1 Re: Testimony of Dr. Hanemann on Social-Cost Benefit Analysis

Salt River Project's Motion in Limine to Preclude Testimony or Other Evidence Concerning Social Cost-Benefit Analysis

Since the filing of the two motions listed above, another 19 motions have been filed:

- 1. The City of Flagstaff filed three motions but did not request oral argument on any of its motions.
- 2. The Navajo Nation filed four motions and requested oral argument on two motions *in limine*.
- 3. The LCR Coalition filed three motions *in limine* and requested oral argument on one motion.
- 4. The Hopi Tribe filed an additional seven motions *in limine* and did not request oral argument on any of those motions.
- 5. Salt River Project filed two additional motions *in limine* and did not request oral argument on either motion.

In the Joint Motion to Vacate and Reset Oral Argument Scheduled for May 8, 2020, the United States implicitly stated that the opportunity for oral argument was anticipated for Salt River Project's Motion *in Limine* Regarding Redactions to Future Phase Expert Reports. Thus, at this

point in addition to the two motions *in limine* previously scheduled for oral argument, there are requests for oral argument on an additional four motions *in limine*:
