Initial conference set for March 27, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. 19 20 NUMBER OF PAGES: 14 21 **General Explanation** 22 This order opens a case to determine rights to use water on land that the Apache County 23 Assessor has identified as owned by Silver Creek Flood Control District. The first step in this 24 case is an initial conference with the Court, scheduled for March 27, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. to 25 determine if the landowner is interested in pursuing potential water rights. Interested Parties 26 **MUST** attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue potential water rights.

Failure to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss

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of water rights associated with the property.

In this case, David M. Gibson filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-88784 on October 4, 1985, to assert claims to use water on land that appears to include Apache County tax parcel 106-22-002B. This parcel is currently owned by Silver Creek Flood Control District.

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

Details of the Case

On October 4, 1985, David M. Gibson filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-88784 with the following claim:

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by David M. Gibson ("Claimant") and prepared Watershed File Report No. 33-52-CCA-001 ("WFR"), published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("Silver Creek HSR"). The WFR recorded that a diversion from Brown Creek was supplying water to Ortega Lake, a storage reservoir used primarily for flood control. ADWR found that Ortega Lake is located within NWNWNW Section 6 Township 10 North, Range 24 East. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B. A copy of a map displaying the area investigated by ADWR, denoted by "(1)," is attached as Attachment C.

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Claimant and Landowners

The WFR listed Silver Creek Flood Control District as the owner of the property investigated in 1991. According to maps obtained from the Apache County Assessor ("Assessor"), the land investigated appears to comprise Apache County tax parcel 106-22-002B.

39-88784 and to resolve the objections to WFR 33-52-CCA-001.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR

A copy of the map on file with the Apache County Assessor, showing the relevant tax parcels and current ownership, is attached as Attachment D. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR to any of the current landowners, and the current landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs.

Property owners must present to the Court evidence showing that a water right exists on their property. This evidence may include the WFR. Alternatively, the property owners may settle with objectors. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of water rights on its property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an Order from the Court, and all parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the property mentioned in this order. 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5. Court-Approved Mailing List.

- 1. Case Initiation. This contested case shall be known as *In re Silver Creek* Flood Control District, and it will resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statement of Claimant 39-88784 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 33-52-CCA-001.

- 3. Parties. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, and all parties who filed objections to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in this case are the Salt River Project, the United States, the Arizona State Land Department, the Hopi Tribe, the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe, and the Navajo Nation.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

ATTACHMENT A

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.


