The first 25 step in this case is an initial conference with the Court, scheduled for April 10, 2024 at 10:00 26 a.m. to determine if landowners are interested in pursuing potential water rights. Interested 27

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Parties MUST attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue potential water rights. Failure to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of water rights associated with the properties.

In this case, Augusta T. Larson filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-88372 on behalf of Jefferson J. Larson on October 10, 1985, to assert claims to use water on land in NESE Section 25 Township 9 North, Range 22 East.

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

Details of the Case

On October 10, 1985, Augusta T. Larson filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-88372. The SOC contains the following claims for water rights:

Quantity	Water Source	Water Use
6.00 acre-foot annually (AFA)	Billy Creek	Irrigation
Enough to water 1 horse	Billy Creek	Stock watering

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by Augusta T. Larson ("Claimant") and prepared Watershed File Report No. 33-56-ACDA-012 ("WFR"), published in the Final Silver Creek Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("Silver Creek HSR"). The WFR recorded that water was being used for stock watering and irrigation. ADWR also published a map of the area investigated, denoted by "(12)." A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of the map is attached as Attachment C.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the Salt River Project and the United States. The Hopi Tribe, San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe, and Navajo Nation joined the in the United States' objections.

Claimant and Landowners

The WFR lists Jefferson J. Larson as the owner of the property investigated. According to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor ("Assessor") and documents obtained from the Navajo County Recorder, the land investigated appears to comprise Navajo County tax parcels 212-30-031C and 212-30-031B.

A copy of the map on file with the Assessor showing the relevant tax parcels and current ownership is attached as Attachment D.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs.

To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and present to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This evidence may include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of a water right on their property, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this Order. If you have questions regarding this order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

IT IS ORDERED:

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- 1. <u>Case Initiation</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Jefferson J. Larson II*, and it will resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statement of Claimant 39-88372 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 33-56-ACDA-012.
- 2. Initial Conference. An initial conference shall be held on April 10, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. to determine whether current landowners intend to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. If you receive this order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this order by email, log into the Court Connect program on the internet by typing https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. <u>Parties</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, and any party who filed an objection to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in this case are the Salt River Project, the United States, the San Juan Southern Paiute Tribe, the Hopi Tribe, and the Navajo Nation.
- 4. <u>Objections</u>. Copies of the objection filed to WFR No. 33-56-ACDA-012 can be found under the case number CV 6417-33-6976 on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp.

5. Court-Approved Mailing List.

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment E to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-

approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Apache County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

ATTACHMENT A

General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Little Colorado River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.




