DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Order to vacate and reschedule oral argument on Hopi Tribe's Motion for Entry of Judgment Pursuant to Rule 54(b) and set oral argument on objections to the Special Master's Report dated August 24, 2017. The Hopi Tribe filed a Motion for Entry of Judgment Pursuant to Rule 54(b) (Rule 54(b) Motion) with respect to the Court's minute entries filed March 2, 2009 in Case no. 6417 and January 25, 2016 in Case no. 6417-201. Oral Argument on the Rule 54(b)

Motion is scheduled for August 31, 2017. On August 28, 2017, the Hopi Tribe filed a motion requesting that the oral argument on its Rule 54(b) Motion be rescheduled to coincide with oral argument on objections that it intends to file to the Special Master's Report issued August 24, 2017, in Case no. 6417-203. The Hopi Tribe further requested that this Court set a schedule for the filing of objections, responses and replies with respect to the Special Master's Report and schedule oral argument.

Effective March 17, 1995, A.R.S. § 45-257(A)(2) was amended to provide:

Each claimant may file written objections with the court to any rule 53(g) report within the later of sixty days after the report is filed with the court or within sixty days after the effective date of this amendment to this section. If the report covers an entire subwatershed or federal reservation, each claimant may file with the court written objections to the report within one hundred eighty days of the date on which the report was filed with the court.

The issues in the referenced report are limited to the claims asserted by the Hopi Tribe in its Third Amended Statement of Claimant to water from sources located outside the boundaries of the Hopi Reservation. The scope of this report is narrow as it addressed the Hopi Tribe's claims to off-reservation water sources. The Hopi Tribe's claimed water rights analyzed in the Hopi Reservation HSR for past and present use on the Hopi Reservation as well as its claims for water rights for future use are in the process of being adjudicated. Thus, the 60-day period specified in A.R.S. § 45-257(A)(2) for filing objections governs the filing of objections to the Special Master's Report.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the oral argument on the Hopi Tribe's Motion for Entry of Judgment Pursuant to Rule 54(b) scheduled for August 31, 2017 is vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that objections to the Special Master's Report dated August 24, 2017, shall be due on or by October 23, 2017, responses shall be filed by December 1, 2017, and replies will be due on or by December 20, 2017.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that oral argument on the Hopi Tribe's Motion for Entry of Judgment Pursuant to Rule 54(b) and Objections to the Special Master's Report dated August 24, 2017, shall be held on January 18, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 1201, 201 West Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ, 85003-2202.
