On April 16, 2018, the Arizona State Land Department (ASLD) filed a Report Regarding Its Proposed Ownership of the Water Rights at Issue (Report). After reviewing

the claims underlying the potential water rights at issue, ASLD determined to withdraw the following statements of claimant: 39-6918, 39-6973 and 39-13173.

The Report included a spreadsheet of the potential water rights that contains a column setting forth ASLD's position as to whether the State of Arizona owns the referenced water right. It further requested 90 days to coordinate with the lessee to prepare the proposed abstracts.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Statements of Claimant 39-6918, 39-6973 and 39-13173 are dismissed.
- 2. The Arizona State Land Department and the trustee for the Lackner Living Trust shall file by August 1, 2018:
 - a. Proposed abstracts for water uses described on Exhibit A to the Report for which no dispute exists that the State of Arizona is the owner of the water right.
 - b. A list of proposed water rights for water uses described on Exhibit A to the Report for which a dispute exists as to ownership of the water right.
 - c. The Arizona State Land Department shall file an affidavit signed by the Commissioner of the Arizona State Land Department affirming that the Commissioner has had the opportunity to resolve the claims as required by A.R.S. §45-257(D)(2).
