The Nature Conservancy obtained four Certificates of Water Rights for instream flow right to four reaches of Aravaipa Creek from Arizona Department of Water Resources. In its Statement of Intent and Revised Consolidated Abstracts, filed February 15, 2018, The Nature Conservancy claimed instream flow rights based on the four certificates to Reaches A, B, C, and

D of Aravaipa Creek. At the status conference held on April 10, 2018, a discussion occurred concerning the correct quantity of water to be included in each Proposed Abstract of Water Right. The attached abstracts based on watershed file reports 115-04-011 and 115-05-054 have been prepared with quantities consistent with Certificates of Water Rights.

This order does not address water rights claimed pursuant to Statements of Claimant 39-2116 and 39-11371, which was filed to update and amend Statement of Claimant 39-2116. Nor does this order address Watershed file report 115-04-012 which will be the subject of a separate order.

IT IS ORDERED that the Arizona Department of Water Resources shall review the draft abstracts to verify conformance of the Proposed Abstracts of Water Right to the certificates of instream flow and shall file a report no later than May 21, 2018 setting forth any suggested corrections to the proposed abstracts. The report shall be accompanied by a map of each reach of the Aravaipa Creek identified in the abstracts.
