DECREE 20-0503061 - MAE D. DAVIDSON -VS- WILFORD H. CLARIDGE; ROY CLARIDGE; RAY CLARIDGE; AND HUGH CLARIDGE, ISSUED ON OCTOBER 30, 1940 BY THE GRAHAM COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT ENTERED A STIPULATED DECREE WHICH ESTABLISHED THE OWNERSHIP OF FOUR WATER RIGHTS ORIGINATING IN STOWE GULCH AND DIVERTED BY MEANS OF THE SAME PIPELINE. EACH OF THE FOUR WATER RIGHTS ENTITLED THE PARTIES TO DIVERT AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-HALF OF THE CAPACITY OF THE ONE-INCH PIPELINE AT FOUR DIFFERENT PLACES OF USE FOR AGRICULTURAL, DOMESTIC, AND STOCKWATERING PLACES OF USE.
