DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: The Special Master initiates contested cases W1-11-0018, W1-11-2591, W1-11-2646, W1-11-2656, and W1-11-2694 to address objections to watershed file reports 111-19-001, 113-09-020, 113-11-003, 113-12-001, and 113-12-BD-002. The cases are consolidated under **Contested Case No. W1-11-2694**.

This Order initiates a contested case to resolve the objections made to potential water rights included in the watershed file reports included in the San Pedro Hydrographic Survey Report that analyzed claims filed by or assigned to Pima County. The claims include

potential water rights for irrigation use listed in Watershed File Report (WFR) 113-12-BD-002. In addition, pursuant to A.R.S. § 45-257, which requires that a "claimant's small water use claims¹ shall be determined in conjunction with the determination of that claimant's other claims," this contested case shall also resolve objections to claims that constitute small water uses identified in Watershed File Reports 111-19-001, 113-09-020, 113-11-003, and 113-12-001. Copies of the watershed file reports are included as Attachment A.

#### WFR 111-19-001

This report identifies one domestic use and one stockpond on sections 22 and 27 T19S and R18E. Susan S. Clyne is named as the landowner of the property included in the report. On November 5, 2010, Ms. Clyne assigned Statements of Claimant (SOCs) 39-1724 and 39-1726 for stockpond use located on sections 23 and 27 T19S R18E to Pima County.

#### WFR 113-09-020

Only a single claim analyzed in WFR 113-19-020 is relevant in this case. According to the report, the land involved was owned by the Arizona State Land Department and leased to Jerry and Apryl Brown. The Floyd and Lavita Bingham Family Trust filed SOC 39-2771 claiming 235,000 gallons per year for stock watering from a spring. The Arizona Department of Water Resources determined that the SOC supported a stock watering claim for water diverted from Peck Stream and used on SESW Section 7 T11S R18E. In 2013 the Jack and Lois Kelly Revocable Trust filed an assignment of the SOC to the Oracle Ridge Mining, LLC which then filed an Assignment of the Statement of Claimant to Pima County. In 2015 the Pima County Flood Control District filed an amendment to the Statement of Claimant

A small water use includes stockponds that have a capacity of not more 15 acre feet that is used solely for watering livestock or wildlife and stock watering used by livestock or wildlife. A.R.S. §45-251(9)

claiming a recreation, fish and wildlife use from Peck Stream located on Section 18, T11S R18E, which general legal description is consistent with the WFR.

#### WFR 113-11-003

The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified Joseph Goff as the land owner in Watershed File Report 113-11-003 and SOCs 39-5394 and 39-5395 as the relevant claims for a domestic water use on section 24 T11S R17E and a stockpond on section 21 T11S R17E. Pursuant to an assignment filed August 28, 2006, Mr. Goff assigned SOC 39-5395 to Pima County. On October 4, 2016, Pima County filed an amended SOC for the stockpond reporting that it provides water for 55 cattle for three months and for wildlife for twelve months of the year.

#### WFR 113-12-BD-002

The Arizona Department of Water Resources identified Riley West, Inc. as the land owner in Watershed File Report 113-12-BD-002. This report lists potential water rights for irrigation, a stockpond and a small reservoir on sections 11, 12, 13, 24 T12S and R18E and section 19 T12S R19E. The applicable SOCs are 39-2064, 39-2069, and 39-2079. Pursuant to an Assignment of Statement of Claimant filed May 10, 1999 with the Arizona Department of Water Resources, Riley West, Inc. assigned these SOCs to The Nature Conservancy which assigned the SOCs by an Assignment filed May 27, 1999, to the City of Tucson which assigned the claims to Pima County pursuant to an Assignment filed on December 28, 2004. According to the WFR, the potential water uses are supplied by diversions from the Bayless Ditch, and wells located in sections 13 and 19 T12S R18E.

#### WFR 113-12-001

In WFR 113-12-001, the Arizona Department of Water Resources identified nine potential water uses for domestic, stockpond and stock watering on land that it reported as owned by Riley West, Inc. The listed SOCs include 39-2050, 39-2052, 39-2062, 39-2070, 39-2072, 39-2074, 39-2770 and 39-3637. The SOCs associated with domestic use and stockponds, 39-2050, 39-2052, 39-2062, 39-2070, 39-2072, and 39-2074, were ultimately assigned to Pima County. These six water uses are designated for use in sections 7 T12 R18, 18 T12 R18, 30 T12 R18, 2 T13 R18, 6 T13 R18, 7 T13 R18 and 11 T13 R18. An additional stock watering use on Section 19 T12 R18 was identified for which no SOC was filed. The remaining two SOCS, 39-2770 and 39-3637, for stockwatering uses do not appear to have been assigned to Pima County. These potential water uses are located in Section 7 T12S R18E and Section 19 T12S R18E

The expedited process established in the Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses, dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision") shall be used to prepare proposed water right abstracts for stock watering, stockpond and domestic claims where appropriate.

#### IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Cases, Consolidation, Designation and Docket Number</u>. This contested case initiates case nos. W1-11-0018, W1-11-2591, W1-11-2646, W1-11-2656, and W1-11-2694. These cases are consolidated under *In re Pima County Irrigation*, Contested Case No. W1-11-2694.

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The parties in this contested case are Pima County, all persons who filed objections to the listed watershed file reports who are listed on Attachment B, and claimants who are allowed to intervene by order.

#### 3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case is set forth as Attachment C to this Order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.
