ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME, REQUIRING ASSIGNMENTS TO BE FILED, AND SETTING A SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

CONTESTED CASE NAME: In re Redfield Canyon State Claims.

HSR INVOLVED: San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report.

DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY: Grants the United States request for additional time to file its position regarding SOC Nos. 39-7273, 39-7280, 39-7283, 39-7301, 39-7302, 39-7307 and 39-7308, requires assignments to be filed for ten SOCs and sets a scheduling conference with respect to claims that are not considered *de minimis*.

By Minute Entry filed February 20, 2018, the United States was directed to either withdraw or request that the court consider twelve Statements of Claimant (SOC). On April 5, 2018, the United States filed a request that SOC Nos. 39-7272, 39-7274, 39-7275, and 39-7282 be

retained and considered in this contested case. The United States also requested an additional 30 days to evaluate its position with respect to the remaining eight SOCs which are: 39-7273, 39-7276, 39-7280, 39-7283, 39-7301, 39-7302, 39-7307 and 39-7308. For good cause shown,

IT IS ORDERED granting the United States until May 7, 2018 to either withdraw or request that the court consider potential water rights listed in watershed file report 113-13-007 that reference SOCs Nos. 39-7273, 39-7276, 39-7280, 39-7283, 39-7301, 39-7302, 39-7307 and 39-7308. If the United States elects not to withdraw the above-referenced SOCs, the United States shall include with its filing a list of the applicable pre-filing documents that support the claims for water rights.

The United States and The Nature Conservancy timely filed a joint report concerning ownership of water rights associated with statements of claimant nos. 39-5553, 39-5556, 39-5557, 39-5559, 39-5566, 39-5569, 39-0669, 39-5548, 39-5580, and 39-5598. The parties have agreed that water rights associated with those statements of claimant shall be owned in the name of the United States. Accordingly,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by May 21, 2018, the United States and The Nature Conservancy shall file assignments of statements of claimant nos. 39-5553, 39-5556, 39-5557, 39-5559, 39-5566, 39-5569, 39-0996, 39-5548, 39-5580, and 39-5598 consistent with their joint report.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a scheduling conference shall be held on June 6, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in the Superior Court of Arizona, Central Court Building, Courtroom 301, 201 West Jefferson Street, Phoenix, AZ 85003-2202 for the purpose of creating a case management order that will set deadlines for discovery, dispositive motions and a trial date with respect to those claims for in-stream use that have been certificated.
