21 **CONTESTED CASE NAME:** *In re Subflow Technical Report, San Pedro Watershed*

24 **DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY:** The order sets deadlines regarding processing of
25 stockpond certification and attendant draft abstracts.

26 On June 30, 2026, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”) filed
27 a status report regarding stockpond certification for stockponds that are part of
28 contested cases in the San Pedro watershed. The report listed, by contested case,

1 potential stockpond water rights where a draft abstract has been approved for inclusion
2 in the catalog of proposed water rights, however the final stockpond certification had
3 not yet been completed.

4 ADWR's report identified duplicative filings, typographical errors, and
5 inconsistencies between land ownership and basis of right ownership. In most cases,
6 ADWR made recommendations for the most efficient way to move forward.

7 **IT IS ORDRED** that parties with objections to ADWR's recommendations must
8 file comments no later than **August 14, 2026**.

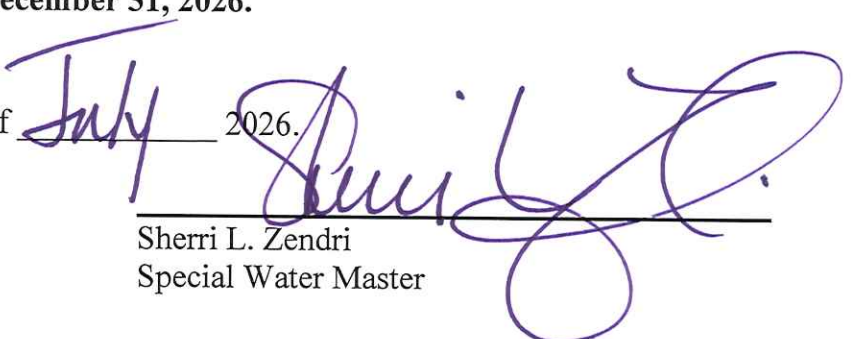

10 ADWR also requested specific guidance regarding potential water rights 115-05-
11 004-SP003 (W1-11-003326) and 115-05-018-SP006 and SP007 (W1-11-003329). Both
12 of these contested cases are ASLD water rights claims.

13 **IT IS ORDRED** that no later than **August 14, 2026**, ASLD shall file comments
14 with the Special Master on how the agency would like to proceed regarding potential
15 water rights 115-05-004-SP003 and 115-05-018-SP006 and SP007.

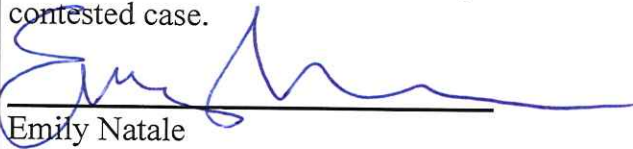
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17 Finally, as part of ADWR's June 30, 2026, report, ADWR requested the deadline
