21 certification, or if certification is complete, filing of proposed abstracts. Therefore,

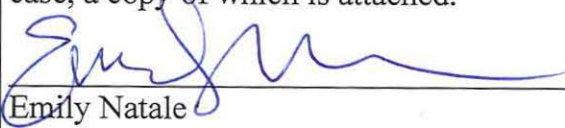
