15 claims for this contested case.

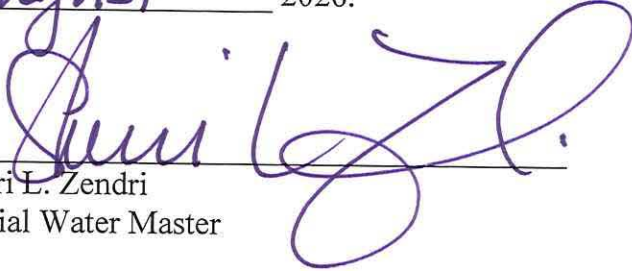

17 This contested case involves a stockpond that spans two land parcels with different
18 ownership. On August 3, 2026, the Arizona Department of Water Resources (“ADWR”)
19 filed an updated map to clearly depict the location of the stockpond across the two parcels.
20 As part of ADWR’s filing, the agency recommends that the Court split the potential water
21 right (“PWR”) for the stockpond listed in watershed file report (“WFR”) 115-05-003 into
22 two separate PWRs. However, because both of the stockponds qualify as *de minimis*
23 claims eligible for summary adjudication, the WFR must accurately document the
24 attributes of each PWR. Furthermore, ADWR has identified a number of inconsistencies
25 with the filings.

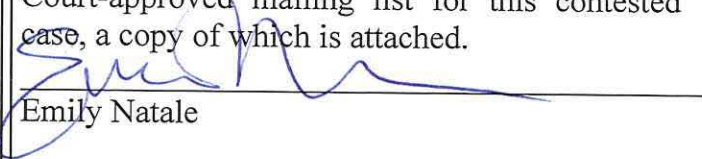
26 **IT IS ORDERED** that parties wishing to move forward with a stockpond claim
27 shall correct the inconsistencies listed in ADWR’s August 3, 2026, filing no later than
28 **October 12, 2026.**

1 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that no later than **December 11, 2026**, ADWR
2 shall file an amended WFR and draft abstracts that reflect ADWR's recommendation for
3 split PWRs and any corrections made by claimants.
