General Explanation

This Order begins the process necessary to adjudicate claims made for rights to appropriable water for use on land that the Arizona Department of Water Resources identified as previously owned by Mary S. Waltrip that has since been subdivided. The Cochise County Assessor has identified several parties who now own portions of the subdivided tract of land.

This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro River Watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Jacob G. Goldberg ("Claimant") filed Statement of Claimant 39-1018 on July 6, 1979 for rights to water from a well on land in Section 31 Township 23S Range 22E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim, which it characterized as a claim for irrigation use and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-23-DA-007 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A.

The WFR found no irrigation use of water on the land described in the WFR. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant ("SOC") relevant to the potential water right: 39-1018. Jacob G. Goldberg filed the SOC claiming water for an irrigation use. The WFR lists Mary S. Waltrip as the owner of the property described, located in the Section 31 Township 23S Range 22E. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include an assignment of the SOC from the Claimant to the successor landowners.

The Cochise County Assessor lists numerous parties who own the land described in the WFR shown in the table below.

IT IS ORDERED:

- 1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re Mary S. Waltrip and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-23-DA-007 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew. asp
- Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, who are included on Attachment D, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified

only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Courtapproved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.

- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County

 Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the

 Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list. Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.
- 4. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether any of the current landowners intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water for irrigation use. If no person appears at the Status Conference, then Statement of Claimant 39-1018 and this case will be dismissed and no further action will be taken with respect to the WFR or the objections filed to the WFR.

The Status Conference shall be held on October 21, 2021 at 1:50 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. 


