General Explanation

This Order begins the process necessary to adjudicate claims made for rights to appropriable water for use on land that the Cochise County Assessor has identified as owned by the trustees of the Leiendecker Revocable Trust. This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal rights to

water. Other cases in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or are awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant for rights to use appropriable water in the San Pedro River Watershed. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Jacob Goldberg ("Claimant") filed Statement of Claimant 39-1018 on July 6, 1979 for rights to water for use on land in Section 31 Township 23S Range 22E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claim, which it characterized as a claim for an irrigation use, and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report No. 111-23-DA-033 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. The WFR investigated the land shown on the map attached as Attachment B.

The WFR showed no irrigation use on the land described in the WFR. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve objections to the WFR.

Claimant & Landowners

The WFR identified one Statement of Claimant ("SOC") relevant to the potential water right, 39-1018, filed by Jacob Goldberg. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include an assignment of the SOC from the Claimant to the successor landowners.

The WFR names DeWayne and Mary Jo Albin as the owners of the property described as located in Section 31 Township 23S Range 22E and more particularly shown on the attached map as in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 31 Township 23S Range 22E. The Cochise County Assessor lists the Leiendecker Revocable Trust as the current owner of tax parcel

nos. 104-44-013 and 104-44-007A. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing these tax parcels and the current owner is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

- Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re DeWayne and Mary 1. Jo Albin and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statement of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 111-23-DA-033 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). - 2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the WFR, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list.

 Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.
- 4. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimant or the current landowners intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water for irrigation use. If no person claiming a water right appears at the Status Conference, then Statement of Claimant 39-1018 and this case will be dismissed and no further action will be taken with respect to the WFR or the objections filed to the WFR.

The Status Conference shall be held on October 21, 2021 at 2:40 p.m. The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment F. 
