Edward Lehner filed Statements of Claimant ("SOC") 39-6018, 39-6019, 39-6020, 39-6021, 39-6022, and 39-6023 (collectively "SOCs") for state law rights to use appropriable water on land in Section 21 Township 23S Range 22E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated those claims and prepared Watershed File Report 111-24-CBB-002 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Zone 2 Well Report 111-24-CBB-002 was also prepared by ADWR during its investigation of the claims made. Based on its investigation, ADWR found potential water rights for domestic and irrigation uses on the land. It identified six wells as the sources of water for the claimed uses. The Arizona Department of Water Resources has determined that wells 1, 5, 6, and 7 are within the subflow zone. A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. The land included within the boundaries of the WFR is shown on the map attached as Attachment B and labeled as "(2)".

This case was initiated and consolidated with *In re San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area* contested case no. W1-11-232 for the purpose of adjudicating the claims for federal reserved water rights and to resolve the objections filed to the WFR. While a portion of the land included within the boundaries of the WFR is owned by the United States, the Cochise County Assessor shows the remainder of the land within the WFR as privately owned and not part of the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area. A copy of the map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor is attached as Attachment C.

The Cochise County Assessor identifies tax parcels 104-37-001E and 104-37-001F as owned by Gary H. Fry and Karen Taylor Fry Family Trust and Phelps Dodge Corporation, respectively. Accordingly, this contested case is deconsolidated from *In re San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area* contested case no. W1-11-232 for the purpose of adjudicating claims for water rights on land not owned by the United States.

Claimants

Edward Lehner filed the SOCs listed in the WFR on June 2, 1980. On January 19, 2007, SOCs 39-6018 and 39-6022 were assigned to Phelps Dodge Corporation. The public records maintained by ADWR do not include assignments of the remaining SOCs from Edward Lehner to successor landowners. Thus, the Claimants in this case are Edward Lehner and Phelps Dodge Corporation.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Deconsolidation.</u> In re Edward and Ethelyn Lehner, contested case W1-11-1343 is deconsolidated from In re San Pedro Riparian Conservation Area, contested case W1-11-0232 for the purpose of adjudicating claims for rights to water for use on privately owned land. All motions filed concerning water rights for land within the boundaries of Watershed File Report 111-24-CBB-002 that is privately owned shall use contested case no. W1-11-1343 in the caption.

2. <u>Status Conference</u>.

- a. A Status Conference shall be held to determine whether the Claimants and the trustees of the Gary H. Fry and Karen Taylor Fry Family Trust intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water for irrigation and domestic use on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR.
- b. The Status Conference shall be held on December 3, 2021 at 1:30 p.m.


