General Explanation

This Order begins the process necessary to adjudicate claims made for rights to appropriable water for use on land previously owned by Riley West, Inc., an Arizona corporation.

This contested case is one of the many cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been

made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or are awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, David E. Alm ("Claimant") filed eight Statements of Claimant on April 9, 1980 for rights to water in Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 16 of Township 16S Range 20E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims, which it characterized as claims for four irrigation uses and one domestic use and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report ("WFR") 112-14-DDB-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map of 112-14-DDB-001 prepared by ADWR for the WFR is attached as Attachment B with the land associated with this case labeled as "(1)".

The WFR found four irrigation uses and one domestic use of water supplied by wells located within the subflow zone on the land described in the WFR. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified eight Statements of Claimant ("SOC") relevant to the potential water right: 39-2925, 39-2930, 39-2931, 39-2932, 39-2933, 39-2934, 39-2935, and 39-2936. David E. Alm filed the SOCs claiming water for irrigation and domestic uses. The WFR lists Riley West, Inc. as the owner of the property described, located in Section 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, and 16 of Township

16S Range 20E. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain an assignment of any of the statements of claimant.

The Cochise County Assessor lists Cross Y, LLC, an Arizona limited liability company, as the owner of the property described in the WFR. The records of the Cochise County Recorder show Riley West, Inc., an Arizona corporation, conveyed the land described in the WFR to the Matthew Krumpotic and Rachel L. Krumpotic Living Trust by two special warranty deeds, recorded as documents 1998-20783 and 1998-17482. On May 3, 2004, the trustees of the Matthew Krumpotic and Rachel L. Krumpotic Living Trust conveyed the property to MMK Investment Services Limited Partnership, LLLP by special warranty deed, recorded as document 2004-13765. MMK Investment Services Limited Partnership, LLLP conveyed the land described in the WFR by warranty deed to Cross Y, LLC, on March 26, 2021, recorded as document 2021-08303. The Cochise County Assessor lists Cross Y, LLC as the owner of tax parcel nos. 208-27-001, 208-27-002, 208-26-001B, 208-26-016, and 208-26-012. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing these tax parcels is attached as Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Contested Case. This contested case shall be known as In re Riley West, Inc. and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 112-14-DDB-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current 2. landowners, all persons who filed objections to the Watershed File Report who are listed on Attachment D, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.




