In this case, Joseph Pones filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-6365 on July 1, 1980, to assert claims to use water on land in Section 17 Township 16 South, Range 20 East.

The first step in this case will be an initial conference, where landowners will state whether they intend to pursue water rights.

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Additional background information on the process for determining water rights in Arizona can be found on Attachment A.

Details of the Case 10

On July 1, 1980, Jospeh Pones filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-6365, which 11 claimed rights to use groundwater for domestic and irrigation purposes. 12

13 The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made 14 by Jospeh Pones ("Claimant") and prepared Watershed File Report No. 112-14-DDC-001 15 ("WFR"), published in the Final San Pedro Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("San 16 Pedro HSR"). The WFR recorded that a well in SESENE Section 17 Township 16 South, Range 17 20 East was being used for domestic and irrigation purposes. The WFR also recorded that surface 18 water was being used for stockpond purposes. ADWR also published a map of the area 19 investigated, denoted by "(1)." A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of 20 the map is attached as Attachment C.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by

the United States, ASARCO, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto

Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Tribe, the Camp Verde Reservation, the Salt River Project,

and Chester C. Antonick.

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Claimant and Landowners

The WFR lists Chester C. Antonick as the owner of the property investigated. According
to maps obtained from the Navajo County Assessor ("Assessor"), the land investigated appears
to comprise the tax parcels listed in Attachment E.

A map showing the relevant tax parcels, the San Pedro River subflow zone, and the
approximate location of the well supplying the domestic and irrigation uses detailed in the WFR
is attached as Attachment D.

8 The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any
9 assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have
10 filed any additional SOCs.

To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and present to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This evidence may include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of water rights on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this Order. ATTACHMENT A

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General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels", groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Gila River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.




