Fenn. This contested case is one of the many 26

cases in the General Stream Adjudication for the San Pedro River Watershed to determine legal

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rights to water. Other cases in which claims have been made for legal rights to water in the San Pedro River Watershed have been completed, are in the process of determining water rights, or awaiting initiation. The purpose of the General Adjudication is to determine the rights of those persons who filed statements of claimant for rights to use appropriable water in Arizona. The General Adjudication will also determine water rights in the Upper Salt, Verde, Upper Gila, Lower Gila, Agua Fria, and Upper Santa Cruz watersheds.

In this case, Alvah F. Fenn filed two Statements of Claimant on July 10, 1980 for rights to water in the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of Section 28 Township 16S Range 20E. The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims, which it characterized as claims for irrigation use and prepared a report known as Watershed File Report ("WFR") 112-17-BAB-002 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map of 112-17-BAB-002 prepared by ADWR for the WFR is attached as Attachment B with the land associated with this case labeled as "(2)".

The WFR found three irrigation uses of water supplied by one well located within the subflow zone on the land described in the WFR. The WFR found another well that supplies water for stock watering use and that well is also within the subflow zone. After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR. The purpose of this case is to consider the claims made for water rights that are the subject of the WFR and resolve the objections to the WFR.

Claimants & Landowners

The WFR identified two Statements of Claimant ("SOC") relevant to the potential water right: 39-6663 and 39-6665. Alvah F. Fenn filed the SOCs claiming water for irrigation use and

 that water was first put to beneficial use on the property in 1918. The WFR lists Alvah F. and Barbara H. Fenn as the owners of the property described as located in the southeast quarter of Section 28 Township 16S Range 20E. On August 12, 1998, Alvah F. and Barbara H. Fenn conveyed the land described in the WFR to Jenifer J. and Michael F. O'Callaghan by warranty deed, recorded as document no. 1988-16760. The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources contain an assignment of both SOCs to Michael and Jenifer O'Callaghan ("Claimants") on June 24, 1991.

Jenifer J. and Michael F. O'Callaghan conveyed the land by warranty deed to Lynette H. and Stuart A. Lott as tax parcel no. 208-61-001, recorded as document no. 2001-07377 on March 19, 2001. On July 31, 2009, Lynette H. and Stuart A. Lott conveyed, by warranty deed, tax parcel no. 128-61-001 as five lots: A, B, C, D, and E to Rhino Investments, LLC, and Arizona Limited Liability Company, recorded as document 2009-18795. Rhino Investments, LLC has conveyed those five lots to Shannon E. and Jennifer Rea Thomas as tax parcel nos. 208-61-001A, 208-61-001B, 208-61-001C, 208-61-001D, and 208-61-001E, recorded as document 2021-05272 on February 26, 2021. The Cochise County Assessor lists Shannon E. and Jennifer Rea Thomas as the current owners of the land described in the WFR. A copy of a map prepared by the Cochise County Assessor showing these tax parcels is attached as Attachment C. The WFR area is outlined in blue on the tax parcel map in Attachment C.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re Alvah and Barbara Fenn* and it will determine appropriable water rights asserted in the Statements of Claimant and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report 112-17-BAB-002 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website:

2. <u>Litigants</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant3, the current landowners, all persons who filed objections to the Watershed File Report who are listed on Attachment D, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

3. <u>Court-Approved Mailing List.</u>

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list.

 Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Courtapproved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the Court-approved mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list. Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.

4. <u>Status Conference.</u> An initial status conference shall be held to determine whether the current landowners intend to pursue claims for rights to appropriable water for irrigation and stock watering uses. The Status Conference shall be held on **December 3, 2021 at 4:00 p.m.**The Status Conference shall be held using the Court Connect program. 


