within the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area ("Fifth Report") in response to the January 18, 2023, Order from this Court. The Fifth Report was required to provide the status of several specific Statements of Claimants ("SOCs") and any other corrections necessary to ensure the United States' state-law claims for water rights in the San Pedro Riparian National Conservation Area are accurately reflected. An April 5, 2023, order from this court summarized the changes that resulted from the Fifth Report.

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The filing of the Fifth Report did not, however, resolve all issues with these state

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- 1. Commenting on draft proposed abstracts for the following PWRs: 111-20-032-SP001, 111-24-CCB-011-SP002, or 111-24-CCB-011-SP003.
- **2.** Issuing draft proposed abstracts for 111-20-032-SP001, 111-24-CCB-011-SP002, 111-24-CCB-011-SP003.
- **3.** Informing the court of progress in the issuance of water rights certificates for instream flow claims found in SOCs 39-14485, 39-14482, and 39-7752 and a deadline for the completion of this task.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that by April 1, 2024, the United States shall file a report:

- 1. Providing a final, exhaustive list of all Statements of Claimant ("SOCs") containing claims that the United States will be pursuing in W1-11-232 including any claims that are not documented in SOCs as of the filing of this Order. This list shall also include all claims to be investigated in the San Pedro II HSR.
- 2. Confirming the appropriate surface water filing has been initiated for any claim lacking a surface water filing.
- 3. Providing, in accordance with ADWR's November 2022 comments, evidence for the location of the spring or stockpond relevant to the following potential water rights: 111-20-032-SP002, 111-20-032-WL001, 111-20-032-WL005, 112-17-063-SW001, 112-17-063-SW002.
- 4. Confirming that, for any relevant SOC not originally in the United States' name, the United States amended the name on the SOC or obtained an assignment.
- 5. Confirming that all relevant SOCs and/or assignments have the proper claimant name and address.
- 6. Informing the court of progress in the settlement of the instream flow claim in SOC 39-13611.
- 7. Informing the Court of the non-*de minimis* claims that it believes are most amenable to settlement.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED scheduling a status conference on April 30, 2024, at 10:00 am to discuss the following:

- 1. Any suggested corrections to the draft abstracts for de minimis claims.
- 2. A timeline for the settlement of the instream flow claim in SOC 39-13611.
- **3.** Whether roadblocks are anticipated regarding the settlement of instream flow claims in SOCs 39-14485, 39-14482, and 39-7752.
- **4.** A timeline for the settlement of the non-*de minimis* claims included in the United States' most recent report.
