This order opens a case to determine rights to use water on land owned by Walterio Romero. The first step in this case is an initial conference with the Court, scheduled for **April 25, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.** to determine if landowners are interested in pursuing potential water rights. Interested Parties **MUST** attend the scheduled initial conference if they plan to pursue potential water rights. Failure to appear at the initial conference could result in the dismissal of the case and the loss of water rights associated with the properties.

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In this case, Walterio Romero filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-2402 on

On December 31, 1979, Walterio Romero ("Claimant") filed Statement of Claimant ("SOC") 39-2402, which claimed rights to use groundwater for domestic and irrigation purposes.

The Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") investigated the claims made by the Claimant and prepared Watershed File Report No. 114-04-BAB-033 ("WFR"), published in the Final San Pedro Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991) ("San Pedro HSR"). The WFR recorded that a well in SWNWSW Section 5 Township 6 South, Range 16 East was being used for domestic and irrigation purposes. The WFR also recorded that surface water was being used for stockpond purposes. ADWR also published a map of the area investigated, denoted by "(33)." A copy of the WFR is attached as Attachment B, and a copy of the map is attached as Attachment C.

After ADWR issued the WFR, objections were filed to the findings made in the WFR by the United States, ASARCO, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Tribe, the Camp Verde Reservation, and the Salt River Project.

#### **Claimant and Landowners**

The WFR lists Walterio G. and Teresita Romero as the owners of the property investigated. According to maps provided by ADWR and the Pinal County Assessor

IT IS ORDERED:

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("Assessor"), the land investigated appears to comprise Pinal County tax parcels 300-18-017A, 300-18-017B, and 300-18-017C.

A copy of a parcel map of the investigation area provided by ADWR is attached as attachment D. A map showing the relevant tax parcels, the San Pedro River subflow zone, and the approximate location of the well supplying the domestic and irrigation uses detailed in the WFR is attached as Attachment E.

The public records of the Arizona Department of Water Resources do not contain any assignments of the SOC listed in the WFR, and the current landowners do not appear to have filed any additional SOCs.

To pursue water rights, a property owner must file a Statement of Claimant and present to the Court evidence of the existence of a water right on their property. This evidence may include the WFR. If either the property owner proves to the Court the existence of water rights on their property or enters into a valid settlement approved by the Court, the Court will recognize enforceable water rights in a "Final Decree." Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-257(B).

This is an Order from the Court. All parties must comply with the following instructions. The failure to obey this, or any, court order may result in the dismissal of this case and the loss of any potential water rights associated with the properties mentioned in this Order. If you have questions regarding this order or any of the attachments, please contact the General Stream Adjudication, Office of the Special Water Master, at (602) 372-4115. Please note that staff can only answer administrative questions and cannot provide legal advice.

1. <u>Case Initiation.</u> This contested case shall be known as *In re Walterio G.* and *Teresita Romero*, and it will resolve claims to appropriable water asserted in Statement of Claimant 39-2402 and objections that were filed to Watershed File Report No. 114-04-BAB-033.

- 2. <u>Initial Conference</u>. An initial conference shall be held on **April 25, 2024, at 10:00 a.m.** to determine whether current landowners intend to pursue claims for water rights. The conference will be held using the Court Connect program. Instructions for Court Connect are attached as Attachment G. If you receive this order by email, click on the red box "Join Court Connect Hearing" on the attached instructions to make an appearance. If you do not receive this order by email, log into the Court Connect program on the internet by typing <a href="https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster">https://tinyurl.com/specialwatermaster</a>. If you do not have access to the internet, you may attend telephonically using the telephone number and access code included in the instructions for Court Connect.
- 3. <u>Parties</u>. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimant, the current landowners, and any party who filed an objection to the Watershed File Report. The objectors in this case are the United States, ASARCO, the Gila River Indian Community, San Carlos Apache Tribe, Tonto Apache Tribe, the Yavapai-Apache Tribe, the Camp Verde Reservation, and the Salt River Project.

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#### **ATTACHMENT A**

#### General Background on the Water Rights Determination Process in Arizona

A general stream adjudication is a judicial proceeding to determine the quantity and priority of all water rights in a river system. Arizona is undertaking general stream adjudications of both the Gila River and the Little Colorado River systems. A river system includes surface water flowing "in streams or other natural channels," groundwater sufficiently connected to that surface water, and water subject to claims by the federal government. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-251(7). Recognizing and respecting water rights and the priority of such rights is important in Arizona where times of drought or water scarcity can occur.

All cases begin with the filing of a "Statement of Claimant," ("SOC") in which a property owner makes a claim for a right to use surface water on their property. Ariz. Rev. Stat. § 45-254(A). This person is the "claimant." The SOCs contain, among other characteristics, a description of the source and quantity of the water used, the location of use, the location from which the water was diverted, and the date when the water was first put to use. *Id.* § 45-254(C).

After the property owner files the SOCs, the Arizona Department of Water Resources ("ADWR") prepares a "Watershed File Report," ("WFR") in which ADWR investigates the claims in the SOCs and recommends water rights associated with the property. *Id.* § 45-256(B). ADWR compiles all WFRs for a watershed into a comprehensive Hydrographic Survey Report ("HSR") and publishes the report for public review and comment. In response, other claimants in the Adjudication may file "objections" disputing the information or recommendations in the WFR. The individuals who file objections are called "objectors."

This "contested case", one of thousands in the Gila River System, will evaluate claims asserted in specific Statements of Claimant while considering objections to the WFR that reported ADWR's initial inspection of those claims.






### WFR Map




