This Order initiates a contested case to consider the claims for water rights and resolve objections to Watershed File Report 115-06-001 ("WFR") published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). The WFR identified potential water rights for stockponds and stock watering use on land located in sections 21, 27, 34, and 35 of Township 7S Range 21E. A copy of the Watershed File Report is attached as Attachment A. A copy of the map prepared for the WFR is attached as Attachment B. The land that is the subject of the WFR is labelled as "(1)" on the map.

Claimants & Landowner

The WFR identified Statements of Claimant 39-2164, 39-4980, 39-4981, 39-4984, 39-6977, 39-6978, 39-6979, 39-6991, 39-13180, 39-13183, 39-13184, 39-13185, and 39-13186 ("SOCs") as the relevant filings for the potential water rights filed by the following claimants:

Adjudication of Claims

Under current law, a claimant who has asserted claims for irrigation use and Small Water Use Claims shall have the Small Water Uses Claims determined in conjunction with the claims for water for irrigation use. A.R.S. §45-257(A)(1). The term "Small Water Use Claims" includes claims for stock watering and stockponds with a capacity of not more than 15 acre feet. A.R.S. §45-251(9). The trustee of the Magoffin Family Trust asserted claims for water for irrigation uses *In re Karen C. LeCourt*, contested case no. W1-11-3395 that were resolved by stipulation. Pursuant to the requirements of A.R.S. §45-257(A)(1), the Small Water Use Claims asserted for water on the land included in the WFR, which is leased in part to the trustees of the Magoffin Trust, shall be adjudicated.

Abstracts for De Minimis Claims

In 1994, the Special Master issued a Memorandum Decision, Findings of Fact, and Conclusions of Law for Group 1 Cases involving Stockwatering, Stockponds, and Domestic Uses,

dated November 14, 1994, amended February 23, 1995, approved and modified September 27, 2002 ("Decision"). The Decision established the procedures for adjudicating *de minimis* water rights for claims in the San Pedro watershed. This procedure applies to the water rights for stockponds and stock watering.

As required by the Decision, proposed water right abstracts have been prepared for the *de minimis* water rights analyzed by the WFR, which are attached as Attachment C. The abstracts will be reviewed by Arizona Department of Water Resources who will provide comments and maps designating the point of diversion and place of use. Upon receipt of a report from the Arizona Department of Water Resources, the draft abstracts will be revised as necessary and distributed to Claimants for suggested corrections.

Ownership of Potential Water Rights

Permits and certificates for rights to water used on state land are governed by A.R.S §37-321.01. The statute requires that permits and certificates for the right to use water on state land for stock watering uses or stockponds shall be issued in the name of the State of Arizona except in three situations. Accordingly, if the current lessees intend to assert rights to water for use on the land, the lessees and the Arizona State Land Department shall meet to discuss ownership of the water rights for stock watering and stockponds on the land included within the boundaries of the WFR and submit a joint report to the Court regarding their position as to the ownership of the potential water rights.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. <u>Contested Case</u>. This contested case shall be known as *In re SLD – Magoffin IV* and it will address the Statements of Claimant listed above and the objections to Watershed File Report

115-06-001 published in the Final San Pedro River Watershed Hydrographic Survey Report (1991). Copies of objections can be found under the case name and number on the following website: http://www.superiorcourt.maricopa.gov/SuperiorCourt/GeneralStreamAdjudication/whatsNew.asp

 Litigants. The litigants in this contested case are the Claimants, the current lessees, all persons who filed objections to the Watershed File Report, who are included on Attachment D, and parties who are allowed to intervene by order.

Court-Approved Mailing List.

- A. The initial Court-approved mailing list for this case shall include all persons listed on Attachment D to this order. The list may be modified only by filing a motion with the Special Master to amend the Court-approved mailing list. Litigants are responsible for using the current Court-approved mailing list.
- B. A copy of any pleading filed with the Clerk of the Maricopa County Superior Court in this case shall be served upon each person listed on the Court-approved mailing list.
- C. Claimants wishing to be added or removed from the mailing list shall file a motion with the Special Master. Parties allowed to intervene will be automatically added to the mailing list.
- D. The Clerk of the Court will send copies of all minute entries and orders issued in this case to the parties listed on the Court-approved mailing list. Upon request, the Clerk of the Court will provide copies by email. Parties may request emailed copies of minute entries and orders by completing and submitting a CONSENT FOR ELECTRONIC RECEIPT OF WATER CASE DOCUMENTS, which is attached as Attachment E.

- 4. By **November 22, 2021**, ADWR shall review and file a report with its comments on the draft abstracts attached as Attachment C and prepare maps regarding the potential water rights.
- 5. By **December 2, 2021**, the Lessees who intend to assert water rights and Arizona State Land Department shall file a joint report regarding ownership of the proposed water rights identified in the draft abstracts attached as Attachment C.


