The Salt River Project has requested clarification of the Special Master's order denying the United States' motion for a temporary stay as to whether pending future time lines have been suspended. The answer is yes.

After the United States files its status report next month, the Special Master will set new time lines for disclosure statements, discovery, motions, and a conference. The Special Master is concerned that the progress of this case will be affected by unknown or long term financial pressures and encourages the United States to provide the best possible prognosis that will facilitate the setting of realistic time lines.
