**THE COURT FINDS:**

1. **ACTION: This case has come before this Court for a Decree of Annulment of Marriage.** The Court has taken all testimony needed to enter a final Decree, or has determined testimony is not needed to enter the final decree.
2. **JURISDICTION: This Court has jurisdiction** over the parties under the law, and the provisions of this Decree are fair and reasonable under the circumstances.
